### 1. Appearance

In the box below please enter as many aspects of Doctor Doom's appearance as you can think of.

**Examples:** for Wonder Woman you might enter "tiara; wrist amulets; red bustier; black hair" or for Superman "blue costume; red cape; red pants; S symbol on chest".

#### 2. Names and titles

In the box below please enter ways that Doctor Doom is addressed, either by other characters, the narrator, or himself.

**Examples:** for Superman you might enter "Kal El; Clark Kent; Man Of Steel; Man Of Tomorrow" or for Doctor Who "The Doctor, Doc; Professor, John Smith; The Oncoming Storm".

### 3 Physical actions

In the box below please enter specific physical actions that you associate with Doctor Doom.

**Examples:** for Doctor Who you might enter "runs down corridors; uses sonic screwdriver; regenerates" or for Spider-man "climbs walls; shoots webs; swings through city".

## 4. Behaviours

In the box below please enter general behaviours or personality traits that you associate with Doctor Doom.


Examples: for Spider-man you might enter "guilt-ridden; wise-cracking; always late" or for the Thing "self-pity; loyalty; love for Alicia".

## 5. Dialogue

**Examples:** for the Thing you might enter "it's clobberin' time; what a revoltin' development" or for Sherlock Holmes "elementary my dear Watson; the game's afoot".






