Introduction

Please note that the Conservation of Books and Paper within Camberwell College of the Arts, University of the Arts London is no longer offered.

Conservation education in Books and Paper at Camberwell College of Arts (Figure 1) formally started in 1970, having grown out of a strong British tradition in bookbinding and typography dating as far back as 1904. At that time, the college was known as the Camberwell College of Arts and Crafts. Conservation education has evolved over the last fifty years in response to the development of Conservation both in the UK and globally.

For many years, Camberwell offered a three-year BA in Conservation of Books, Paper and Textiles, and a one-year Diploma in Books and Paper Conservation followed by a one-year MA. From 2007 to 2011, in conjunction with the British Library, a two-year book conservation foundation degree course was offered to students without the necessity of having an undergraduate degree. These courses were amalgamated in 2011 into a two-year MA with two pathways: Works of Art on Paper and Books and Archival Material.

Students have been drawn from all over the world, from the UK and Europe, Africa, Australia, Canada, China, Japan, Korea,

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Mexico, Middle East, South America, Taiwan, United States of America and New Zealand.

As well as three permanent staff members, the course was fortunate to draw on leading conservation specialists working in a range of museums, libraries and archives, primarily in London. Book conservation students were engaged in bookbinding history courses provided by Ligatus, a research centre within the University. A unique aspect of the course was that placements within institutions were built weekly into the core programme. Longer summer placements were held by students in a diverse range of institutions throughout the UK, Europe and the United States.

Students valued the course being held within an arts university where they observed the process of making and could partake in classes such as drawing. Camberwell graduates are employed in major institutions throughout the UK and across the world and have played an important role in the formation of Conservation within the UK.

Despite the significant international history of Conservation at Camberwell as one of the pioneering conservation training facilities in book and paper conservation and the success of the MA degree in terms of recruitment and employment, the management of the University of the Arts London chose to close this course in 2019.
