
# Summary report of trip to Dzaleka Camp, Malawi Oct 31 – Nov 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024.



## **Purpose of trip:**

### Dzaleka Arts Lab.

- 1/ To continue to meet with and nurture the co-development of the Dzaleka Arts Lab community. (DAL)
- 2/ To review the artefacts and pieces made since our last trip and to offer design expertise to encourage further use of imagination in collaborative making and quality.
- 3/ To film and interview the DAL community.
- 4/ To introduce DAL to digital art making through practice.
- 5/ To begin to create the DAL website and online presence.
- 6/ To start new embroideries which symbolise the spirit of DAL.

1/ To convene two educational meetings to explore a fashion design-focused course delivered online via the Whatsapp platform.



#### **Outcomes:**


#### **Dzaleka Arts Lab:**

- Further development of ways of working with the community to reflect the reality of refugee life.
- A DAL website designed by David Betteridge to bring all projects to date online.
- A first series of digital artworks.( Al being trained on the "Pockets of Love" piece to create other new artworks for sale).
- A series of DAL portraits.
- Film footage & interviews with DAL community, to be included in a wider film about the nature of this work and the collaboration it involves.
- Poems created for the DAL community by Namad MUTU for the website.
- Reciprocal making project new embroidered works begun by DAL that have been taken back to London College of Fashion (UAL) for students to respond to and return to DAL in May 2025.
- Further exchange between makers and making across DAL and London College of Fashion students & course leaders with the "Courage Coat" brought back to DAL. (worn by Light in film by Johnson)
- Live film mentoring of Johnson (Dzaleka film maker)



## **Imagining Possibilities:**

- Two meetings, on November 7th and November 12th, were held to establish interest and explore the possibilities for scoping an online course in fashion design education.
- Best 'conditions for learning' explored and articulated.
- 40 emergent core questions to take back to Whatsapp/ META and UAL to help define next steps.
- New knowledge on the challenges and opportunities for this idea.
- New partnerships established to help continue the develop of the idea.
