Primitive Streak

Primitive Streak is a stunning textile collection that tells the story of the first 1000 hours of human life. Created by fashion designer Helen Storey and developmental biologist Kate Storey, Primitive Streak illustrates key events in human embryonic development, from fertilisation, to the formation of the spine, nervous system, the heart and lungs. This is a rare opportunity to view five key pieces from the world renowned collection, which will be hosted at Debenhams and the Royal Exchange Theatre during the Manchester Weekender and Manchester Science Festival. There will be an in-conversation event held on Sunday 30 October.
